Environmental update: Phase 2 preparations underway

You may have noticed that certain trees have been marked, and some vegetation will start being cleared in specific areas of the estate. We want to assure all residents that this activity is part of a carefully planned and approved process by the developer as they prepare for Phase 2 of the estate.

A comprehensive nature survey has been conducted to ensure that all environmental considerations are respected, and the necessary approvals are in place. The work is being carried out responsibly, with a focus on sustainability and minimal disruption to the natural surroundings.

We appreciate your understanding and support as our community continues to grow thoughtfully and in harmony with the environment.

Building compliance and Architectural regulations

Regular estate inspections are being conducted to ensure compliance to rules and regulations.

After successfully identifying and marking Fire Hydrants the next task is identifying water shut-off valves. Many are covered under vegetation and sand so an exercise will be conducted during June to clear, mark and paint all points.

Currently there are many dwellings under construction on the estate which leads to large trucks and builder's vehicles traveling on the estate roads. Please could all take extreme care while going in and out of your homes as we tend to think there is no traffic.

The estate is starting to really take shape so let's all add our small contribution and keep our areas clean and tidy.

Please note that during the construction of Phase 2, the dirt road between Britannia Beach Estate and Britannia Reef will be designated routes for construction vehicle access.


